

Blackboard


The platform you will most frequently use is Blackboard. You can also find this through students.uu.nl. Here you can find things like your homework, grades and course catalogues.

1. The Drift

Here us Media and Culture students have most of our classes. You enter through drift 27 (The University Library). Fun Fact: this was emperor Napoleon Bonaparte's Dutch residency.

2. The AKT living room

This is the meeting spot for AKT'ers. Here we play games, eat cookies and use the Wii. Come up between 11:00 and 15:00 every weekday and chill. It's only a 5 minute walk from the drift! Address: Kromme Nieuwegracht 20 (top floor on your right).

3. Café De Stadsgenoot

This is the bar where AKT has its monthly borrels (get-togethers). Every last monday of the month we meet there and catch up. Every couple months at these borrels a PLAKT is



released as well. All AKT'ers are welcome to join, so come visit us on **September 30th** at Breedstraat 8 and take a look at last year's AlmanAKT, while chatting with AKT'ers

4. Club Poema

On mondays ("poemaandag"), beer is only 1,90 for students. Some of us like to go there after a fun monthly borrel.

5. ICU

On the west side of the city centre is de ICU. ICU stands for International Campus Utrecht and it houses about 700 students from around the world. But it also contains a lot of University Buildings and you'll probably have some classes here.

6. Science Park

This is where the larger part of the University of Utrecht building are. It's a little further from the city center but very accessible through public transport. This is also referred to as De Uithof.
